The simple past tense is used to talk about finished actionss in the past. <u>Key Words</u>: **yesterday , last week , last month , last year , ago, In 1980,etc ..** 

### <u>Affirmative</u>:

(I, You, We, They, He. She, It) + verb 2
e.g. He visited the museum yesterday. They listened to music last night
<u>Negative</u>: S + didn't + verb + object.

## Salma cleaned the room .

Salma didn't clean the room .

### <u>Yes l No Question</u> : Did + S + infinitive + ?

Did he play football ? Yes, he did ./No, he didn't

### Wh Question + did + S + infinitive ?

What did he write ?

He wrote an essay.

I wrote an email. I didn't write an email .

Did she play tennis? Yes, she did. / No, she didn't.

Where did you play? I played in the park.
